

How to Apply

Applicants must be over 23 years of age. You are required to fill out an application form and return it to An Tóchar Adult Education Centre, you will then be called for an interview to determine your suitability for the course. Applicants who are in receipt of social welfare may apply for financial assistance through the Michael O Regan Bursary.

The course fee is €650.00. When you are offered a place, a deposit of €100.00 is required and the balance is due before the start date.

When will it be held?

The course will run on the following Friday's and Saturday's from 9.30 to 4.30pm: 12th & 13th October, 9th & 10th November, 30th November & 1st December, 11th & 12th January 2019, 22nd & 23rd February, 8th & 9th March.

- Experiential counselling skills and practice.


Learning Outcomes
